

ACNMWA 2022 Internship Program Guidelines

- Neither an applicant nor an institution will be granted the award two years in a row.
- The applicant's project needs to demonstrate that the internship will further her program of study or contribute to her knowledge base in her art/fine art major.
- Applicant must pre-contact/collaboratively organize the internship with the institution.

*NOTE: The arts organization must **NOT** be affiliated with the applicant's educational institution.*

- Applicant must provide proof of institutional availability and participation. The applicant needs to clearly identify the person at the arts organization who will oversee the proposed project and mentor the applicant.
- The proposed internship must clearly outline deliverables: what the student will do, areas of participation, role within the project, assistance to the arts organization, etc.

NOTE: Specific information is preferred and demonstrates that the applicant has been in touch with the arts organization.

- The project that is mutually beneficial is paramount; however, the applicant should show a track record of responsibility and achievement in her academic career.
- The stipend is to be used for the intern's expenses: the funds are not a donation to the cooperating institution or organization (to fund or purchase supplies for the project).

NOTE: The cooperating institution or organization receives a \$500 stipend from ACNMWA.

- Recipient must complete the project within the calendar year of receiving the stipend.
- Recipient must submit a report of how the stipend was used to the ACNMWA Internship Committee.
- Recipient must make an oral presentation to the ACNMWA Board of Directors upon the culmination of the project.
